

CT Hort Cares Grant Application

Thank you for applying for a CT Hort Cares grant. We aim to expand the Society's efforts to educate our great state on the importance of plants and our precious environment.

Please be aware that grants must be requested BEFORE the start of a project. Completed projects will <u>not</u> be considered.

The grant must be used on a project taking place within Connecticut. The maximum amount that can be requested is \$500.

We are accepting proposals through **April 15**, **2025**, with grants distributed on **May 1**, **2025**. If there are additional files or photos that you would like to include with your proposal, please email those to office@cthort.org and reference the name of your project in the subject line.

Applicants will be notified via email of the status of their application.

We ask that those awarded grants report back on the progress of their project; including photos, which may be used in our communications. We also request that CT Hort be recognized for their support of your efforts and will provide a simple garden marker for this purpose.

Please note that once you begin your online application, you cannot save it and return to finish later. We suggest you download a copy to review before you fill out the application online.


